HIGH ALTITUDE TIPS

Colorado Springs is 6,035 feet in elevation and Manitou Springs, just five miles to the west is 6,412 feet in elevation and altitude sickness is common.

Here are some tips for a great Colorado vacation and experience

- KEEP HYDRATED
 - Drink plenty of water, dehydration is common and add a sports drink with electrolytes if
- MONITOR YOUR ALCOHOL INTAKE
 - At higher altitudes, its easy to get super tipsy, super fast completely by accident
- PROTECT YOURSELF FROM THE SUN
 Don't forget a hat, sunscreen and sunglasses the sun is extremely intense
- **BE LAZY AND RELAX AT FIRST**
 - Your body needs some time to adjust to the dry, low oxygen conditions
- WATCH WHAT YOU EAT
 - Eat foods like broccoli, bananas, avocado, cantaloupe, celery, greens, bran, chocolate, granola, dates, dried fruit, potatoes and tomatoes to help balance your electrolytes



ROKU SMART TV INSTRUCTIONS:
